

Ecuador – Galapagos Land Based



Trip Summary

Snorkel with sharks, walk amongst giant Galapagos tortoises, and relax on the beach with sea lions on this six-day adventure in the Galapagos! Experience the best of San Cristobal and Santa Cruz, including their beautiful landscapes, amazing wildlife, and laid-back beach towns. Then, get a taste for the remote as you visit two of the unpopulated islands of the Galapagos, all led by a top naturalist guide. Enjoy various and dynamic ways to access these wild sites by snorkeling, boating, hiking and more. End each night with exceptional service, comfort, and cuisine of the finest hotels in the Galapagos.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival / San Cristobal

Upon arrival at San Cristobal Airport from Quito or Guayaquil, you will be met by your local expert guide who will transfer you to your accommodation in time for an energizing lunch, introductions, and a short overview of the trip • Next we stop at the local interpretation center to learn about the unique wildlife, geology and natural history of the Galapagos • Our minds fresh with knowledge, we'll make our way to Frigate Hill where our relaxing walk reveals fauna, wildlife, and scenic views of the beach and sea cliffs below • On the way back stop for a refreshing snorkel at Carola beach and say hello to the sea turtles and sea lions • Return to the hotel for dinner and finish up your first day with a leisurely walk down the boardwalk • *Overnight Golden Bay Hotel & Spa (L, D)*

Day 2: San Cristobal

Today we take to the water with our snorkels and fins to meet some of San Cristobal's marine residents • Hug the coastline searching the coves and cliffs for sea turtles, sea lions, blue-footed boobies, spotted eagle rays, starfish, an abundance of tropical fish and more • Depending on park regulations, we may visit Leon Dormido (Kicker Rock) or Punta Pitt • After a full day spent exploring the seas, we head back to our hotel for a delicious gourmet dinner and a laid-back evening overlooking the bay • *Overnight Golden Bay Hotel & Spa (B, L, D)*

Day 3: Santa Cruz

A speedboat or internal flight takes us onward to Santa Cruz Island • After checking in, we head to the highlands of El Chato to walk with 100 year old giant tortoises, pintail ducks, Darwin's finches, frigate birds, egrets, and the vibrant vermilion flycatcher • Next we'll visit a group of cavernous lava tunnels once frequented by pirates, and was rumored to be the hiding spot for plundered Inca gold • Carry on to Los Gemelos, a pair of massive volcanic sinkholes at the high point of the island • Explore the surrounding forest of Scalesia trees home to the short-eared owl • In the afternoon we'll stop at the Charles Darwin Research Center where we'll learn about the ongoing conservation efforts to protect the future of the Galapagos • After a full day, we make our way back to the hotel, where we'll sit down to a delicious dinner and enjoy secluded views of the bay, coastline, and town • *Overnight Angermeyer Waterfront Inn (B, L, D)*



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Days 4 & 5: Plaza Islands / Bartolome Island / North Seymour Island

For the next two days we'll depart from Santa Cruz to explore two of the nearby small islands: Plazas, Bartolome, or North Seymour • On the Plaza Islands we'll snorkel and hike the crescent-shaped islands famous for the sea lion population, diverse flora and fauna, land iguanas, red-billed tropicbirds, and prickly pear cacti • Bartolome Island, a volcanic islet just off the east coast of Santiago Island, offers some of the most beautiful lava formations • Here we'll hike and snorkel with sharks, sea turtles, penguins, and thousands of tropical fish in the turquoise water • On North Seymour Island we'll observe the incredible birdlife, seeing how the blue-footed boobies hunt, interact, and engage in flamboyant mating rituals • Boats depart to different islands on a weekly schedule, so our destinations will depend on your days of travel • The boat rides should take between one to two hours each way • Each day we'll enjoy delicious breakfasts and dinners at our hotel and field lunches while exploring • *Overnight Angermeyer Waterfront Inn (B, L, D)*

Day 6: Departure / Guayaquil or Quito

Today it's time to bid a fond farewell as we transfer to Baltra Island for our return flight to the mainland • Your guest coordinator will facilitate your airport transfer • *No overnight (B)*

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Activities

Hiking – 1 to 5 miles per hike, easy to challenging terrain.

Boating – 2 to 3 hours per boating day

Snorkeling – Equipment provided; no experience necessary.

Discovery – The rugged volcanic landscape of the Galápagos Islands offers truly exceptional encounters with wildlife. Venture out each day with a skilled naturalist by boat, foot, or snorkel to witness an astounding variety of exotic creatures that have never learned to fear human contact. Your guides will also share with you the history of the pirates, whalers and early settlers who took refuge on the islands of the Galápagos. Discover a land created by volcanic activity where lava fields still dominate the landscape, ash pockets remain untouched, and black sand covers many beaches. Did you know that with over 560 native species, the Galapagos has over 180 endemic species, found nowhere else on the planet? Discover the differences between the diverse and unique ecosystems on and between the Islands. Learn to tell apart the land iguana and the less colorful, but equally impressive marine iguana. Listen to stories of Charles Darwin and the infamous Darwin finches whose evolutionary discoveries led to many present day scientific theories. Seek out the incredibly vibrant marine life of the Islands, keeping a watchful eye out for sharks, sea lions, starfish, turtles, and a wide array of colorful fish. Find out just how blue a blue-footed booby's feet really are! Come explore the Galapagos Islands with the experts in adventure travel!

Nights 1 – 2: Golden Bay Hotel & Spa

Golden Bay Hotel & Spa is a Premium Class beachside property overlooking the spectacular bay that frames Puerto Baquerizo Moreno.

Nights 3 – 5: Angermeyer Waterfront Inn

The Angermeyer Waterfront Inn, accessible only by water, is a Premium – Class hotel with a private location across the Puerto Ayora bay. Once you arrive in Santa Cruz, our hospitality team will take you by boat to our private pier. The main reception and lounge area is a historical site, the famous Angermeyer Cave, which was hand-built by the early settlers to the Galapagos Islands. The main buildings, uniquely constructed out of lava rock and driftwood from the area, are an authentic mix of natural highlights and modern comforts. The newly renovated rooms were designed with comfort in mind, and several even feature hot tubs. Our signature waterside restaurant overlooks the Galapagos' busiest bay and remains true to the Santa Cruz vibe.

Amenities: Cable TV, air conditioning, free Wi-Fi, hair dryer, breakfast, hot tubs, and restaurant

Meals

You will fly from Quito or Guayaquil to the Galapagos Islands, arriving between 11:30 am and 1:30 pm to San Cristobal airport, depending on your flight schedule. Upon arrival at San Cristobal airport, you will be greeted and escorted by a Neotropic Expeditions representative. Your trip ends with a drop-off at the Baltra airport, on time for your flight back to the mainland. From Quito or Guayaquil, you can make your post trip connections.

The following cancellation policies and cancellation fees are in effect:

Cancellation 90 days or more before trip departure – Full trip payment refunded less a \$300 per person administration fee

Cancellation 60-89 days before trip departure – Full trip payment less 20% is refunded

Cancellation 45-59 days before trip departure – Full trip payment less 50% is refunded

Cancellation 30-44 days before trip departure – Full trip payment less 75% is refunded

Cancellation 0-29 days before trip departure – No refund is given
